What is an Ordinance?

What is an Ordinance? Ordinances generally govern matters not already covered by state or federal laws. An Ordinance is considered the most authoritative form of action taken by Council, and once adopted, the ordinance becomes an establishes law in DuBoistown Borough. The majority deal with maintaining public health and safety, zoning, public morals, behavior and general welfare.

DuBoistown Borough uses the International Property Maintenance Code Book along with specific ordinances adopted by council. A copy of these can be obtained at the Borough Office and will be available on line in the near future.

Below is a list of violations that you could receive notices for.

Grass and weeds may not exceed 6” in height.

Grass and weeds may not be placed in the roads or alleys.

No piles of brush shall be placed in yards.

No rubbish, junk or garbage shall be placed in yards, driveways or porches.

No indoor household furniture (i.e. recliners), appliances, scrap metal may be stored in yards, driveways or porches.

No pools shall be installed without obtaining a building permit.

Burning paper and paper products shall be permitted during the following times: Monday through Friday from 7:00 am till 7:00 pm Saturday 7:00 am till Noon **NO BURNING ON SUNDAY OR HOLIDAYS!**

Street Projects

The Borough has a couple of street projects happening this year!

EDGEWOOD & COCHRAN – UGI has replaced metal pipes with plastic and will be inspecting main hook ups. The Borough of DuBoistown will be repairing the manhole covers and working on stormwater drains as soon as UGI project is complete. Paving is tentatively scheduled for 2021!

BROOK & ARCH – WMWA (Williamsport Municipal Water Authority) is replacing water main on Brook Street and across Arch Street. The Borough of DuBoistown will be doing some repair work to stormwater drains in conjunction with this project. Paving is tentatively scheduled sometime during the September 2020!

EUCLID – UGI has replaced some gas mains. No update on Penn Dot Paving.

CLAREDON – Borough of DuBoistown Storm water upgrades and repair of hole. Completed End of July 2020.

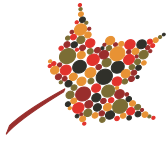
ARLINGTON – Storm Water repairs and paving. DuBoistown Borough is working with South Williamsport and HRI as a joint effort to get the entire street in both boroughs paved. We will share in the cost of the paving. Tentatively Complete September October 2020!

We received Dirt & Gravel Grant for the repair work on Woodside and Edgewood. Updates will be available soon on start date.

The Borough Manager is working closely with the Public Works Employees, Engineer & Utilities Companies to identify areas in need of repair to assist in putting together a project list and maintenance schedule for our streets, stormwater & sewer systems.

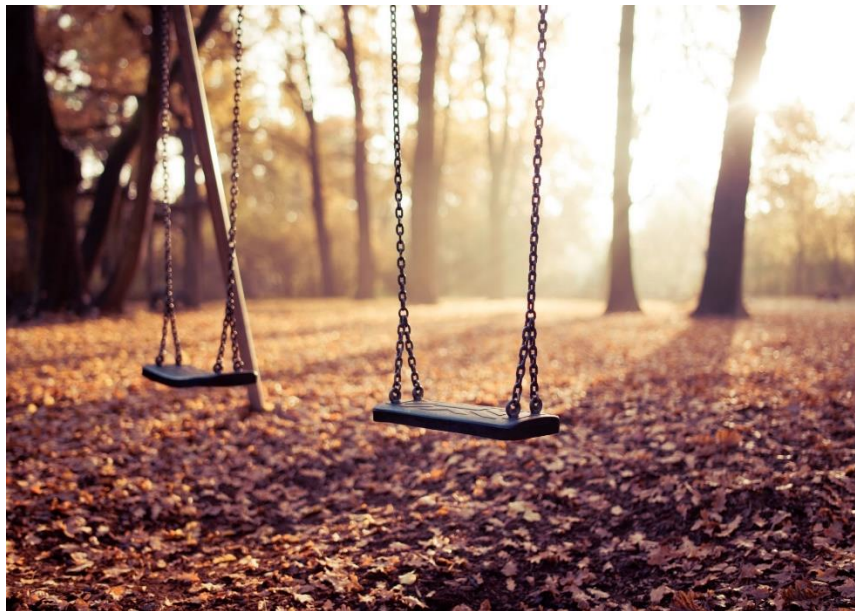
LEAF PICK UP
