§ 121-1. Unnecessary noise prohibited.

The making of unnecessary, unusual or any other noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others within the limits of the Borough is declared to be a public nuisance. Enumeration of the particular offenses hereinafter particularly defined shall not be construed as limiting the generality of the section or limiting the offenses hereunder to particular offenses hereinafter enumerated.

§ 121-2. Squealing of tires.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating any vehicle in the Borough of DuBoistown to cause the tires of his vehicle to squeal and thereby cause noise and disturbance to the peace of the community, and the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance. The squealing of tires in an emergency situation is hereby excepted.

§ 121-3. Barking dogs.

It shall be unlawful for the owner or one who has the custody or control or the keeper of any dog to allow a dog to bark in such a manner and with such frequency so as to annoy, disturb, injure or endanger the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others, and the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

§ 121-4. Violations and penalties. [Amended 12-10-1998 by Ord. No. 1998-2]

Any person or persons who violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500, plus costs of prosecution, for each offense, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding 90 days.
